### Friendly Reminder:

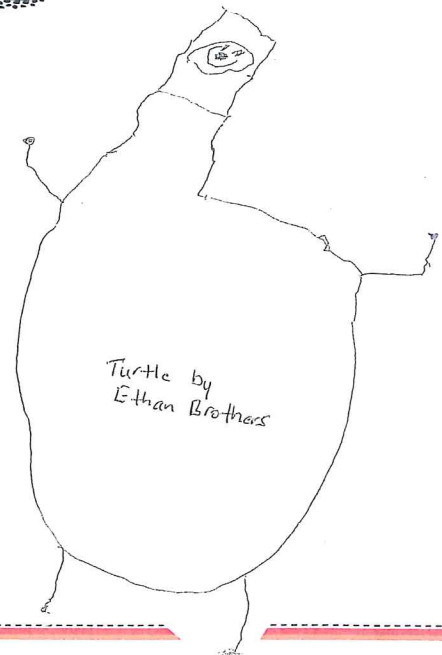

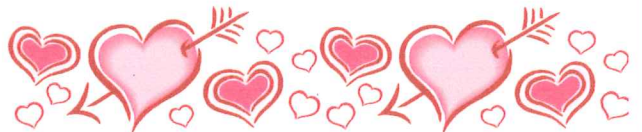
